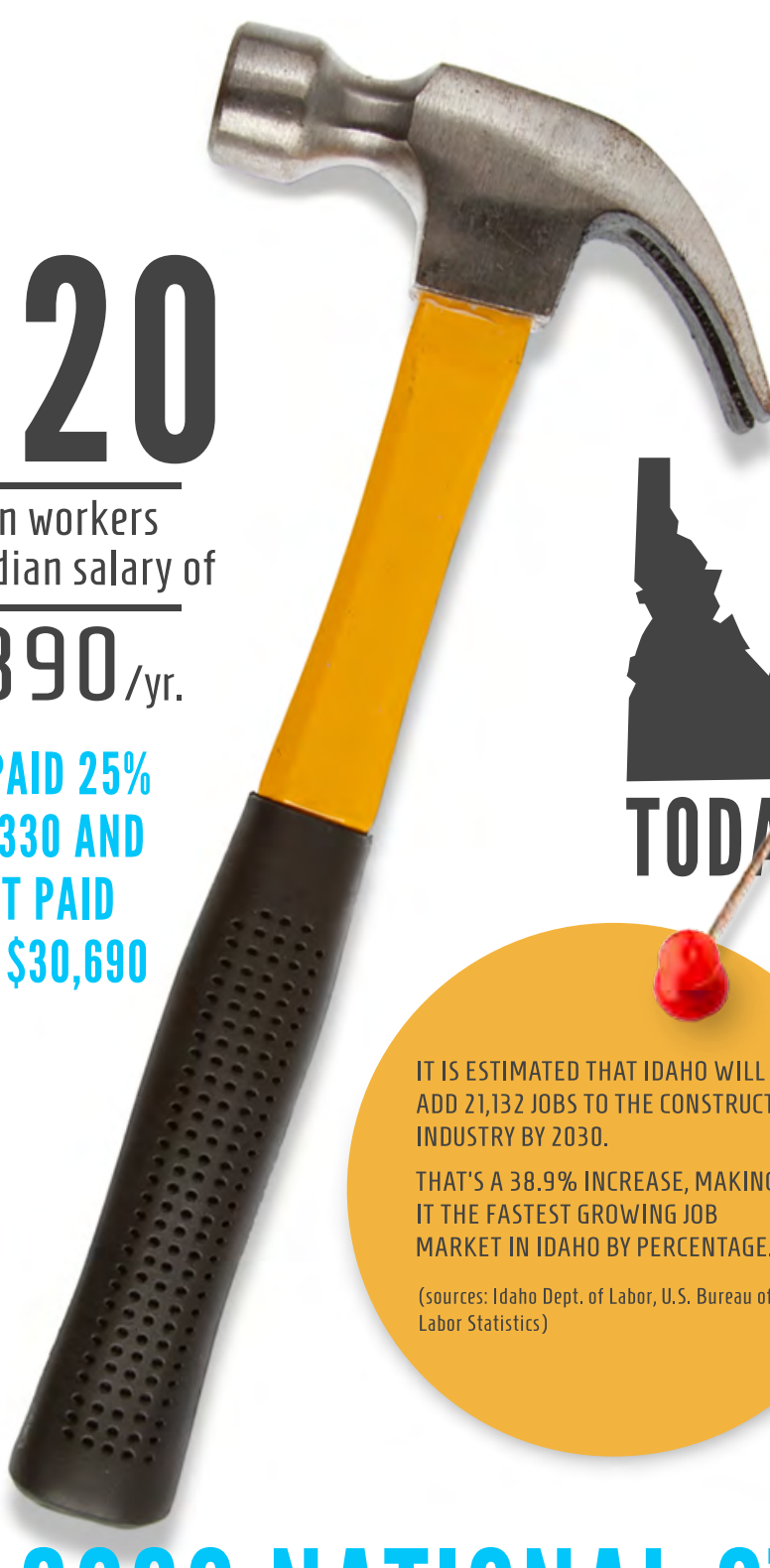

Construction and extraction occupations are projected to grow 6% between 2020 and 2030 nationally, about as fast as the average for all occupations and gain about 400,000 new jobs.

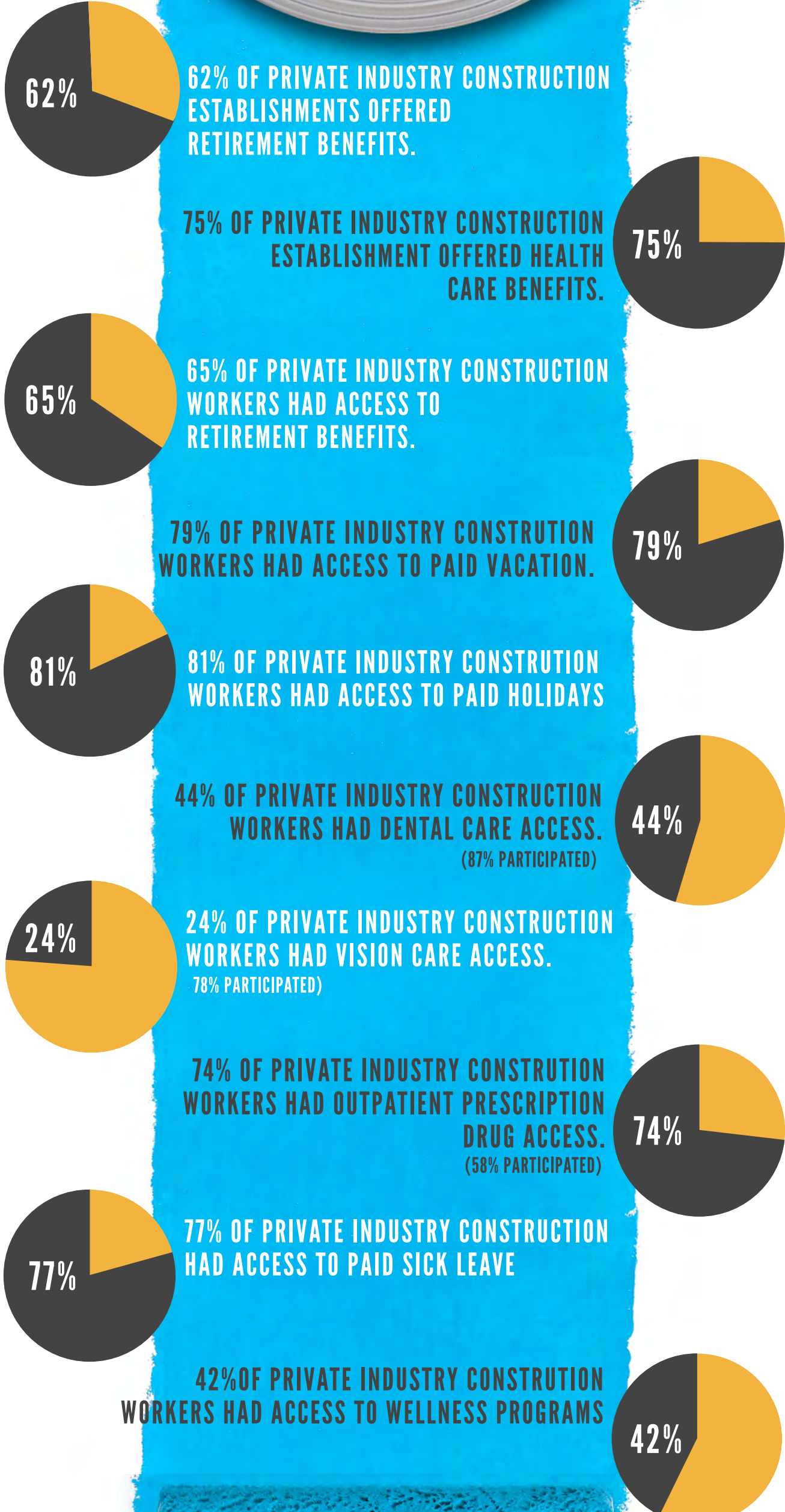
The construction and extraction industry is projected to be the fastest growing industry in the nation by percentage between 2020 and 2030.

In 2020, annual pay of all construction workers in the United States averaged \$67,357. That's 4.8% more than the average for all private sector employees in the country.
